In this day-long workshop, participants will explore ways to bring primary sources into the classroom. Beginning with the special effects presentation *Ghosts of the Library*, this session will delve into the importance of preserving primary sources and the stories they can tell us about our past. Participants will examine documents from the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library collections, including civil war letters, political cartoons and Lincoln's family correspondence. They will learn how to identify primary sources, determine their credibility as a source, analyze their content, and become familiar with print and digital resources available through the ALPLM. The day will also include a complimentary tour of the Library and Museum.
